General PTO Meeting
November 5, 2008
Minutes – Approved

1. Welcome and Introductions: Member in attendance introduced themselves.

 - Auction Refund of \$1100 needed, with two options provided:
 - 1) Refund from 08-09 Income and budget. – or -

Judy Nelson moved to motion for 5 month CD with 2.75% renewal rate due in April 2009.
