4. PTO Activities Recap:
 - a. Kids Care Campaign – Campaign was a success.

7. Unfinished Business:
 - a. Entertainment Books – Held an email and a meeting vote and no one voted against the continuation of this fundraiser. The PTO will continue this next year.
 - b. 2010-2011 Committee Chairs – Julie discussed openings for next year and asked for volunteers to fill those positions.

d. Playground

- i. Walking Trail – Mary Jean Hutchinson presented the proposal to build a walking trail to the general membership. She estimates that the project will cost between \$29,000 and \$32,000 to complete. The trail will be 8 feet wide and approximately 1/3 mile long. Following the presentation and a discussion amongst the membership, the membership voted to approve setting aside \$32,000 for the project. Once the project is approved by District 90 the City of O’Fallon will solicit bids and bring the bids back to the general membership for selection of contractor.

8. New Business

- a. Pinnie’s Purchase – Mrs. Eiskant has asked the PTO to purchase pinnie’s for use during lunch fitness and PE. The total cost is \$125.79. Judy made a motion to approve the request. Alicia Lewis seconded the motion. The general membership all approved the request.
- b. Flag Purchase – Mrs. Burns has asked the PTO to purchase two United States of American flags for the school. The cost for two flags is \$97.56. Judy Mack made a motion to purchase the flags. Linda Whitehead seconded the motion. The membership all voted to approve the purchase.
