MOYE MUSTANG INTERNET SAFETY TIPS - May

Parent and Kids – talk together about your own safety rules when on-line surfing and social networking, including:

- **Don't give out personal information such as names, school, city, or e-mail address, or post pictures online. Once an image is posted anywhere on the Internet (even on a profile with private settings), it may never be completely erased from the Internet, even if it is deleted.**
- **Don't communicate with people you have never met in person—that person on the Internet may not be who they say they are.**
- **Kids – tell your parents, teacher or another adult if you have ever been threatened or feel uncomfortable about something that you've experienced on-line.**
