Reading Counts

The Moye PTO sponsors 'Reading Counts', a program to help encourage young readers. The library and classrooms have books marked with dots that indicate a reading level. After the child has read the book they can take the associated quiz. If the child passes they can earn points and if they don't pass they can try again, another day. Points are tallied at the end of the month to achieve a Reading Counts Level Blue or Gold. The principle will announce the accomplishments and the student will receive a small mustang and a token prize for their appropriate level. Additionally, random prizes are awarded to RC test takers each quarter. Please remind your child it only takes one test to get them into the random draw.
