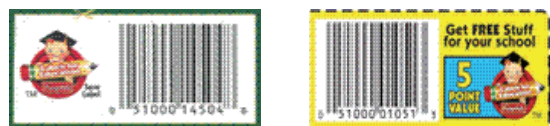
BoxTops
