Edgar Degas: "Dancing Class"

Project: Resist in Motion

Materials:

Stencils

Scissors

Card Stock

Pencil

Crayons or Markers or Chalk

Process:

1. Use the one of the provided stencil and trace around the stencil with crayon.
2. Next, move the stencil slightly, perhaps a ½ inch or so, and trace the stencil again using a crayon of the same color or different color.
3. Then, move the stencil slightly again, and trace. Continue moving the stencil and tracing each move. This repetitive tracing will make the object look like it is in motion and speeding across the paper.
4. The traced shapes can be colored-in with any variety of crayon colors.
5. Background can also be colored.
