

James Montgomery Flagg was an early master of pen and ink, but he was much more. Born in 1877, he grew up along with the reproduction technology that allowed artists to select the pen as the illustrative tool of choice. A true child prodigy, Flagg sold his first illustration, to the prestigious *St. Nicholas Magazine* no less, at the age of twelve. He died in 1960, he was elected to the Society of Illustrators Hall of Fame in 1980.

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
