James Montgomery Flagg: Uncle Sam "I Want You"

Project: Persuasion in Art

Materials:

Cardstock (1 piece per student) or large white construction paper
Pencil
Ruler
Markers
Crayons

Process:

(Very similar to Option 1)

1. Think of something in the world that you would like to change. (i.e. poverty, pollution, disease, killing animals, etc.)
2. Now come up with a way to persuade your audience. Is it a character, person or something else that you can make a poster? Think of the ways you can persuade.
 - a. Is it powerful? (President)
 - b. Someone nice (Mother Theresa)
 - c. Someone famous (Bono from U2, Oprah, Brad Pitt)
 - d. Someone made up (character such as Rambo or GI Joe)
3. Once your mind is made up – draw your poster.
