Winslow Homer: "Snap the Whip"

Project: Watercolor

Materials:

8-1/2 x 11 inch watercolor paper (you will have to cut the sheets in half; use workroom paper cutters after 2 pm)

Watercolor paint sets

Cups for clear rinse water

Pencil

Sponges (for wetting paper)

Process:

1. See attached; however, notice that we do not have a mixing area for the watercolors. The students will achieve a similar effect by painting color over color on the wet watercolor paper.
2. Time will probably not allow the paintings to dry so that black pen can be used to outline shapes. The instruction to use black pen to outline shapes would be a nice bit of info to include on the label on the back of the artwork in case the students want to do this later.
