

Fifth Grade 2006 Class Project

Wassily Kandinsky: "Farbstudie Quadrate"

Materials:

Xerox of attached sheet

Oil pastels, crayons, markers, colored pencils (preference is oil pastels, easy to blend)

Canvas (24"x36")

Paint brushes

Paint palettes

Acrylic paint

Smocks

Process:

Divide class in half.

One group: Students will color one circle and background per rectangle on sheet of 8-1/2 by 11 paper. They may use the color combinations to create their rectangle on the large canvas.

Other group: Following Kandinsky's design, paint one rectangle to include one oval/circle, radiating lines and background.
