## **Paul Klee – Sinbad the Sailor**

### Materials:

Black Construction Paper  
All types of scrap paper  
Scissors  
Glue – Liquid Glue works best

### Process:

Students study Paul Klee and Sinbad the Sailor

On the Black Construction paper, students will outline a creature with the glue.

Students will use a mosaic process of many colors of scrap paper to manipulate the creature. Many colors should be used – notice the Sinbad the Sailor print and all the shapes and colors used to create the sea creatures.

They can cut the scrap paper or tear it – does not matter.

Add something to the environment to determine where it lives. (sea, space, sun, moon, cave, etc.

This is a great project for the kids that think they cannot draw.
