

Fourth Grade (option 2)

Jacob Lawrence: "Parade"

Lesson: Sequence

Materials:

Xerox paper  
Drawing pencil  
Markers or colored pencils (whole class should use one or the other)

Process:

1. Leader makes a list with the students of things they sequentially do during a particular day. Must have one item on list per student (ie. 30 students, then 30 things sequentially listed). It is wise to use a school day, one on which they have specials.
2. Each student is assigned one listed item on the list then draws that activity.
3. Once the drawings are complete, color the picture.
4. Try to post this project on a bulletin board with a caption such as "A day in the life of a Moyer 4<sup>th</sup> grader..."

Note- List could look like this:

1. Sleeping in room
2. Alarm clock goes off
3. Student rises
4. Gets dressed
5. Eats breakfast
6. Brushes teeth
7. Puts shoes on
8. Walks to bus stop
9. Boards bus
10. Arrives at school
11. At locker
12. Saying "Pledge of Allegiance"
13. etc.
