

**August Macke** was a German [expressionist](#) painter. He was born on 03 January 1887 in Meschede, Germany. During his childhood he came into contact with the work of an artist which he loved and inspired him to be an artist. He was considered very progressive and open to new ideas. His early Impressionist style developed into a use of strong, sunlit color applied in painterly facets of light. In November 1906 he went on a trip to Paris and was introduced to French Impressionism he began to paint in this manner. August Macke was a Cubist, a abstract artist. Macke was killed in battle, at the age of 27, that same year in World War I.

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
