

Waterlilies like Monet

Liquid Glue

Watercolor paper or Card stock

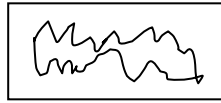
Watered down blue paint in ice trays

Paint brush – medium to thick

Pink/Purple Tissue paper cut in shapes of petals

Green Tissue paper cut in lily pad shapes

1. Pass out paper and put name on the back
2. Give each student glue and have them put a couple of swirls of glue on the paper (see examples below)



3. Give each student a paint brush and ice cube tray with watered down blue paint
4. They now have to paint the water. The glue just gives it texture and a really cool look of water.
5. They then get a lily pad and petals for a flower and glue it all – may stick w/out adding anymore glue.
6. This seems complicated but it is not. The only thing I would add is a big paper on the bottom before they paint to prevent a messy desk.
